The Brazoria County Texas A&M University Mothers' Club will award a \$1000 scholarship to two current student attending Texas A&M University in College Station, TX. If you meet the following eligibility and would like to apply for this scholarship, you must follow the directions outlined below in the **SELECTION** section.

ELIGIBILITY

- Is a graduated senior from an accredited school from these zip codes: 77515, 77516, 77566, 77531, 77542, 77541, 77422, 77486, 77534, and 77480
- Student is a current full-time student at Texas A&M University – College Station Campus and have a minimum GPA of 2.5 (Includes Undergraduate Programs and Graduate Programs).
- Student must exemplify high academic rigor and accomplishment, strong leadership skills, involvement in community organizations and who show dedication to community service and/or employment opportunities based on the information provided in the student's **University Scholarship** application.
- Student is not eligible two consecutive years in a row.

SELECTION

The current student Brazoria County Texas A&M Mothers' Club scholarship winner will be selected by the ***Texas A&M University Office of Scholarships & Financial Aid***. To be considered for the scholarship you must do the following:

- Fill out the 2020-2021 **University Scholarship Application** which opens on October 15, 2020 and closes on February 1, 2021. - Student must have a completed FAFSA on file. Opens October 1, 2020-January 15, 2021.
