Transfer Student to Texas A&M University Students

The Brazoria County Texas A&M University Mothers' Club will award a \$500 scholarship to one transfer student attending Texas A&M University in College Station, TX. If you meet the following eligibility and would like to apply for this scholarship, you must follow the directions outlined below in the **SELECTION** section.

ELIGIBILITY

- Is a transfer student from Brazosport Community College.
- Student plans to be a full-time undergraduate student at Texas A&M University – College Station Campus and have a minimum GPA of 2.5 (Includes Undergraduate Programs and Graduate Programs).
- Student must exemplify high academic rigor and accomplishment, strong leadership skills, involvement in community organizations and who show dedication to community service and/or employment opportunities based on the information provided in the student's **University Scholarship** application.
- Student is not eligible two consecutive years in a row.

SELECTION

This year the Brazoria County Texas A&M Mothers' Club scholarship winners will be selected by the ***Texas A&M University Office of Scholarships & Financial Aid***. To be considered for the scholarship you must do the following:

- Fill out the 2020-2021 **ApplyTexas** application (including the Scholarships portion of the application) opens **August 1, 2020** and is due by **December 1, 2020**. Application is found on <https://www.applytexas.org> or Coalition Application at <http://coalitionforcollegeaccess.org/>

- Student must have a completed FAFSA on file. Opens October 1, 2020 - January 15, 2021.
